#### FELLOWS Program •

A nine-month intensive discipleship and spiritual formation program for people who are committed to meet weekly to discuss assigned reading and its impact on their lives; meet monthly for special programs focused on the integration of faith and calling; experience three weekend retreats over the course of the program; and complete an "integration project" related to their vocation, aimed at helping them flourish in their home, workplace and community.

#### VOCATIONAL Discernment

Periodic classes, seminars, and workshops focusing on discerning one's vocation and calling, and integrating vocation, work, and ministry in Christ.
